SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

The meeting shall be a Sprint event being held at MAKOTRAC International Racetrack, Spring Road Mareeba Qld, and conducted under the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty. Ltd.(AASA), these supplementary regulations and any other regulations or instructions which may be issued.

The event will be conducted under Permit No.

PROMOTERS - The event will be promoted and organised by North Queensland Motorsport Promotions.

The event is open to all persons holding the appropriate competition AASA Club Racing license, or an AASA recognised equivalent standard license (or higher) which must be presented at scrutineering on the day. AASA Club Licences may be purchased on the day of the event for \$50. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with the AASA NCR's.

* **Drivers are required to present their club memberships, competition license, CTP extensions on sign-in.**

* Drivers are required to wear an Australian standard (AS1698) helmet when competing and cars must have an Australian standards (AS1841) fire extinguisher fitted. Seatbelts must be fitted to the vehicle and must comply with current Australian Standards. All competitors must wear non-flammable clothing such as cotton or wool to cover the body from head to toe to wrist whilst competing, and must wear enclosed footwear only. Open toed shoes such as thongs or sandals or high heeled shoes are not permitted. Goggles or visors with lens other than glass in open cars (see Section 2.11 & 2.10 AASA Standing Regulations).

* A battery locator sticker must be attached to the vehicle. All loose objects must be removed from the vehicle

* Drivers are to nominate class from the following;

Class A: under 2000cc

Class B: over 2001cc

Class C: All wheel drive/4WD

Turbo charged and supercharged engines multiply capacity by 1.7

Wankel/rotary engines multiply capacity by 1.8

* It is the responsibility of the driver/service crew to make sure tyres used for the event are approved tyres.

* Gates will open at 7:30am; First round will start at 9:00am

* Drivers are to present cars for scrutineering from 7:30am. Failure to do so will result in not being able to compete.

* Drivers briefing is at 8:30am. Failure to attend the drivers briefing will result in not being able to compete.

* The event will consist of 4-5 runs of 3 laps conducted in one direction of the course.

* It is the responsibility of the driver to be ready to start in the allocated slot. Should the driver not be in place and ready to start, they will forfeit that run.

* At the end of each run the driver must pull back into the pit and into his/her pit bay. Pit area speed limit is 10km/h

* All runs shall be made by a rolling start. The lap will start once the car passes the start/finish line. No burn outs (tyre warming) are allowed in the run up to the start/finish line. A marshal will give the driver the signal to start.

* Penalties will be given in which a competitor's run is not scored and does not count toward results of the competition. The penalty is incurred for:

(i) Shortening the course;

(ii) Departing from the course; or

(iii) Failing to complete a run.

* Drivers who run off the track are required to slow down and rejoin the circuit responsibly. Any car not doing this will be shown a black flag and be required to pull immediately into the pits, 2 black flags will mean dismissal from the event and any further events, forfeiting their entry fee.

* A re-run will not be permitted for this event.

* If a car, due to mechanical failure, or for other reasons fails to reach the finish line, it shall be removed immediately from the course and will be deemed to have made an official run.

* No passengers are allowed in competing vehicles; however senior drivers will be allowed to do observation and instructional runs with a driver if deemed necessary.

* It is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course /Stewards to give a driver a warning under the following conditions:

* If the driver is driving recklessly,

* In an un-sportsman like behavior,

* If the driver is putting his/herself, other competitors and marshals at risk of injury,

* Putting the event into disrepute.

* If after the warning the driver fails to comply with the warning he/she will be asked to leave the event forfeiting their entry fee.

* Competitors failing to adhere to the Clerk of the Course or Stewards requested may have their racing licenses suspended.

During the event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of NQMP is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol or recreational drugs on the day of the event therefore shall not be permitted to participate.

* **Pit area regulations:**

* No smoking

* No chewing gum.

* No toe/service vehicles are to be left in the pit area.

* Refueling is allowed at the Makotrac venue; there is a refueling point at the track, do not refuel in the pit bay.

* Competing cars are only allowed in the pit area.

Trophies will be awarded for; 1st, 2nd and 3rd Outright and A, B and C class winners.
