



## MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT AND ETHICS

The members of the **Australian Auto-sport Alliance (AASA)** agree to adhere to the following commitments:

1. To always adopt honest, transparent and professional practices in their participation in motor racing.
2. To, at all times, obey the laws and regulations of Local, State and Federal Governments.
3. To accept no instructions or inducements, from any other member or interested motor racing party, to relieve the member from his/her responsibility to strictly observe this Code of Conduct and Ethics.
4. To be truthful, avoid exaggeration, concealment or omission in response to any request for information from the **AASA** Board of Directors, Advisory Councils and staff.
5. To regard the maintenance of a proud **AASA** reputation and a high **AASA** standard of ethical practice as his/her direct responsibility.
6. To recognise that other **AASA** members deserve the same attention to their motor racing circumstances as the standard the member would devote to his/her own.
7. To endeavour to respect other members' privacy and Government legislation and regulations protecting such privacy and the need to protect members' confidential commerciality.
8. To utilise the **AASA** internal dispute resolution process, in the event of a serious disagreement with another member.

To recognise that agreement to conduct motor racing endeavours, in accordance with this Code of Conduct and Ethics, is a condition of membership of **AASA**
